

Poster Guidelines and Poster Proceedings

For Conference the posters should be no larger than 2ft by 4ft (60cm x 120cm). The poster should be set out in a visually attractive format, which is both clear and easy to read. The aim is to give a clear overview of the work in progress. Ideally, you should include a section on:

- the rationale or background of the theme/ study;
- aims/focus/research questions (as appropriate);
- a summary of the methods/methodology;
- some presentation of results where these are available.

Some tips:

- Use a font for text which is easy to read - no less than 20 point in size;
- Where possible, use bullet points and break up long paragraphs;
- Try using one or two graphs, charts, diagrams, pictures, etc where appropriate;
- Check if there are no spelling or grammatical errors;
- If you wish to make handouts of more detailed materials available, please indicate this on the poster;
